ROLE: OPUS

Please submit all videos requested below, each as a separate video file.

Quirk of our system note:

YOU SHOULD NOT JOIN THESE VIDEOS INTO A SINGLE FILE. KEEP EACH TAKE SEPARATE. YOU'LL HAVE TROUBLE SUBMITTING IF YOU DON'T.

If you can't get the video files separately, or didn't catch this note before recording your scenes, email us and we'll figure out how to get your video up onto the site.

SHOTS NEEDED

SLATE - CU - include name, age (if under 18), agent, location

SHOT 1 - MED (Waist or Stomach to top of head.)

STAGE: Seated. At table, ideally.

PROPS: Not needed, but if you have some stuff on the table to fiddle with during the scene, it won't

hurt.

Perform Scene 1 as written. Make the opening block of dialogue a continuation of a conversation you've been having with yourself while you were working.

SHOT 2 - MED (Waist or Stomach to top of head.)

STAGE: Seated. At table, ideally.

PROPS: Not needed, but if you have some stuff on the table to fiddle with during the scene, it won't

hurt.

Perform Scene 1 again - Same lines, same shot, but find a different interior space for your character. Have you been waiting for Jackie to arrive? How long? Minutes? Days? Years? Centuries?

Why? We're interested in seeing your ability to change the meaning of the scene through your performance: show us different tactics, adjust where your character was before the scene started and/or anything else that'll explore the scene in new and surprising ways.

SHOT 3 - MED (Waist or Stomach to top of head.)

STAGE: Standing.

Perform Scene 2 as written. We're open to a lot of interpretations of Opus here. Could be loud, could be quiet, could be formal, could be casual. Whatever you want, that suits just fine. This scene can be experimental - maybe you perform the whole thing without actually saying the lines. That'd be fun! (You can also sneak a 2nd take of this scene into our uploader and we won't complain.)

A general note, that if you know better, you can ignore (seriously - what does simon know?)

We'd like *extremely low-key, natural reads for all of these scenes*. We're not looking for show stopping moments for your character, just little peeks into everyday conversation. If you can, check out the first half of Moonlight, The Florida Project or PIG & some Kelly Reichardt movies - some are available for free streaming via various services. They have a consistent style and tone that'll let you know what kind of performances we like.

A NOTE ON CAMERA ANGLES

Ideally the camera should be at face height, so we aren't looking up at you we'd fallen to the floor. The easiest way to accomplish this is with a smartphone and a tripod, but a laptop on a shelf or table also works. Some people have done very clever things with smartphones in soup bowls. Just be careful about precarious balancing of expensive equipment on piles of books. We love electronics and it breaks our hearts when they get hurt.

DETAILS TO NOT SWEAT

The backdrop / scene behind you. We aren't here to judge you or sell scrims or rental time in a self tape studio.

How nice or not nice your camera is - smartphones are fine. Actually, older smartphones tend to be better, because the new ones record GIGANTIC VIDEO.

Editing your video. We very specifically do not want intro cards, a score, super or subtitles or any other additions. Also, please do NOT edit your takes to be one continuous take.

Each of the shots above should be an individual file (or possibly a few, in the case of the physical videos.)

DETAILS TO SWEAT

Can we see your face when we're supposed to see your face?

Can we hear your voice?

Are there significant differences in performance between the takes?

Are the shots listed above individual videos and not combined into a single long video? You'll be in trouble if they are a single long video, like "the site won't accept my submission" level trouble.

Did you do all of the shots above? The site doesn't like partial submissions.

Please do not put a slate before every video clip. We only need it for the slate clip.

DIRECTOR BIO

lan Hubert is *technically* an award winning filmmaker and educator, who's been doing this for a hefty minute. Most of his experience comes as a VFX Supervisor on projects like the feature film Prospect (directed by Zeek Earl and Chris Caldwell) as well as writing, filming, and editing his own short videos to provide a training planform for an ever growing community of visual effects artists. Jackie trips over a doorframe and eats shit. He's appraised skeptically by a man in a wild shirt, sitting outside working on equipment. The man, OPUS, finishes his soldering.

OPUS

You know Dick told me they call it a threshhold 'cause it was the board that held in the thresh flooring. Like wheat stuff. Course Dick doesn't know dick; goes the other way. "Thresh", "to stomp"- clear the mud off your boots, or stomp on grain to separate it from the chaff.

JACKIE

Yeah I-

A piercing tone fills the air.

OPUS

Can you hear this?

Jackie nods. The tone raises.

OPUS

How about now? Wanna keep the damn birds off the new shortwave without making everyone go berserk.

Sure enough- gulls are all over the overhead antenna.

OPUS

You berserk?

JACKIE

Not yet.

Opus dopples the whining speaker maddeningly, then raises the pitch to silent ultrasonic. Jackie gives a nod affirmative. Opus slips on a cover and slams it into a mount.

OPUS

Now we crank it.

He (we can only assume) blasts the volume. The gulls, irritated, fly off. Jackie is impressed, unlike Opus.

OPUS (cont'd)

They were s'posed to explode.

He hops up and gives a still-prone Jackie a hand.

OPUS (cont'd)

Name's Opus. Trying to get a bunk?

JACKIE

Oh- thanks, yeah- I'm Jackie.

OPUS

Jackie?? Any relation to Jackie Tresberg?

JACKIE

No.

OPUS

Broke the mold with ol Tresberg. This way! Watch your step.

He leads him back indoors, leaking thoughts.

OPUS (cont'd)

Doors were huge; before doors everything was contiguous "The World"- suddenly you had inside and outside; humans had to rethink everything.

JACKIE

What about caves?

OPUS

Oh sure yeah always say caves when's the last time you were in a cave? Just in cartoons. Here we are.

They're at the top of a hatch, leading straight into the floor.

JACKIE

It's a floordoor.

OPUS

Floordoor.

JACKIE

Floordoor.

OPUS

On a boat it's called a "hatch".

START 2

INT. BUNKROOM - NIGHT

Jackie's POV- his bunk curtain is ripped open. OPUS sits backwards on a chair, facing us/Jackie. Stares us down.

JACKIE

What's going on, man?

OPUS

Oh not much!! You betrayed me, endangered the lives of my entire crew, and by extension Blahtown. You gambled with everything I care about. Sent us *straight* to the Red Slough.

JACKIE

Look, I-

OPUS

Shh. I've never killed a man in anger- how's it feel?

Tillbat shrugs in a "it's decent" sorta way.

JACKIE

I'm not-

OPUS

Don't talk right now. TERD said they had your sister, somewhere up north. And you, in your way, are risking everything you have— and I have— to bring her back...

Tillbat shakes his head "no", OPUS gives an "eh" grimace.

OPUS (cont'd)

I'm going to give you exactly what you asked for. As soon as we're out of the deathbox you'll go ashore. And you will continue through the Complex on foot, and you will die in the Complex because you were always going to die. The only difference is now I'm sad I won't be able to watch... When did I get so nice?

Tillbat shrugs.

OPUS (cont'd)

Chuck'im in the freezer. I'll see you at dawn.
